Minutes of Meeting

A meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was convened on 02/03/2019 at 04:00 pm in Conference Hall. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the role, quality objectives, strategies, functions and benefits of IQAC to strengthening quality in processes in Academics, Research, and Professional development of students. IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Kalpana Jain welcomed Chairperson and introduced all the IQAC members to the Chair. Meeting started with permission of the Chair. Following points were discussed in the meeting as per the agenda-

1. Nomination and welcome of IQAC members

The Chairperson welcomed all the members present and made aware about IQAC at college level. He declared the IQAC committee members from faculties, stakeholders, students and alumni representatives, employers and IQAC Coordinator. He emphasized on the continuation and strengthening of all four pillar's philosophy of the institute namely, academic, research and innovation, professional competence and social commitment.

2. NAAC accreditation for BTIE as an upcoming mission

Hon'ble member of Management Mr. Santosh Jain elaborated the importance of NAAC accreditation which assesses academic programs and learning outcomes in order to improve students' overall growth. The NAAC accreditation serves a function, which is to maintain the quality of education among institutes. Furthermore, NAAC facilitates central and scholarship programs. Thus, it becomes essential for the Institute to acquire such quality upliftment.

3. To discuss about the strategies, functions and benefits of IQAC

IQAC Coordinator Dr. Kalpana Jain presented the objectives:

A presentation regarding inception of IQAC and its significance was given by IQAC Coordinator. The strategies, functions and benefits of IQAC were decided after a brain storming session among the IQAC members. Principal suggested that quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become a part of the institution's system and work towards realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance also added that the prime task of the IQAC would performance of institutions.

4. Role and responsibilities of IQAC members

IQAC Responsibilities:

- Ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks.
- The relevance and quality of academic and research programs.
- Optimization and integration of modern methods of teaching and learning.
- The credibility of evaluation procedures.

- Ensuring the adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support structure and services.
- Sharing of research findings and networking with other institutions in India and abroad.

IOAC Functions

- Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the institution.
- Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process.
- Arrangement for feedback response from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes.
- Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education.
- Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles.
- Documentation of various programs/activities leading to quality improvement.
- Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices.
- Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality.
- Development of Quality Culture in the institution.
- Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC.

- To ensure heightened level of clarity and focus in institutional functioning towards quality enhancement.

In addition to the detailed introduction of IQAC objectives, functions and benefits, IQAC members were allocated criteria wise work, other members were given a brief about their roles and responsibilities.

5. Meeting of Alumni Association

6. To develop research culture and encourage faculties for the same
